Kona Windsurfing World Championships 2010 and International Windsurfer One Design Freestyle & Slalom Cup

1. RULES

The **Kona Windsurfing World Championships 2010**

1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the ISAF Racing Rules (RR) of Sailing (RRS) including Appendix B (Windsurfing Competition Rules), and the Class Rules of the Kona Windsurfing Association (KWA).
2. If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.
3. The Race Committee will subject boats to random Measurement checks. An appointed committee will check the observance of the rules and the safety equipment. In alteration of RRS 63.1 boats not complying with the rules will be penalized without a protest hearing.

The **International Windsurfer One Design Freestyle & Slalom Cup**

The competition will be governed by the rules set forth on "Overview for Running a Freestyle Event" and the "Judging Instructions"

1. If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

2. ADVERTISING

The ISAF Regulation 20 Advertising Code shall apply.

3. ENTRIES and ENTRY FEE

1. Competitors may register ONLINE: www.mycyouthsailing.org. Go to events Calendar and look for event.
2. Form entries via Mail, or FAX will **NOT** be accepted.
3. Entry Fee includes: Opening Dinner Party, closing ceremony Dinner at MYC, event shirts and lunches.
4. Special Cadet entry fee. (*Cadet: fleet for sailors under 15 yrs on race day*)

NOTE: Registration **International Windsurfer One Design Freestyle & Slalom Cup**. are NOT mandatory and can be done online or onsite on Nov.2nd thru Nov 6th . This is a separate registration transaction.(see fee information below)

FEES: The **Kona Windsurfing World Championships 2010**

Early Registration:

Only Before May 15th : \$100.00 entry fee / \$75.00 Cadets entry fee

From there after:

- After May 15th to September 15th : \$150.00 entry fee / \$90.00 Cadets entry fee
- After September 15th and Before October 15th – : \$200.00 entry fee / \$100.00 Cadets entry fee

Online registration closes on October 15th

ON Site Registration– **ONLY CASH:** \$250.00 entry fee / \$150.00 Cadets entry fee

4. ELIGIBILITY and DISCIPLINE

The **Kona Windsurfing World Championships 2010** is open to all sailors in the following divisions in accordance with the Kona Class Rules:

- Light weight
- Medium light weight
- Medium weight
- Heavy weight
- Ladies
- Cadet (U15 yrs)





The **International Windsurfer One Design Freestyle & Slalom Cup** will be open to all sailors in the following divisions in accordance with the Class and event Rules.

- Men
- Women

5. COURSES and SCORING

1. Kona Course racing; will be defined in the sailing instructions.
2. WOD Freestyle and Slalom disciplines; Sailing Instructions will be announced at the registration.
3. Boats will be scored in accordance with the low points scoring system (App A4).
Up to 12 possible 4 Course races are planned. The worst result(s) of a competitor will be excluded (RR App B8.2): 1-4 races: no race excluded, 5-11 races: 1 race excluded, 12 races: 2 races excluded

6. VENUE

The venue will be MIAMI BEACH (Exact location to be published in later Notice). Depending on weather, sailing in Biscayne Bay will be considered. The Host Club were registration on Nov 1st and Award ceremonies will be held in Miami Yacht Club.

7. SCHEDULE

1. Registration:
The regatta office is located at MYC (Miami Yacht Club) and will be open November 1st from 16:00 - 20:00 pm for package pickup and check in and Opening Ceremony Dinner. There will be also be registration check - in at Venue on Nov 2nd 08:00 am to 12:00 pm. Nov 2nd will also serve as a peactice day.
2. Boats which are not registered at the start of Nov 3nd will be scored DNS.
3. Skippers Meetings:
The locations and times for the Skippers meetings will be published in the sailing instructions or on the Official Notice Board given at registration check in.
The target is to have full days of racing for The Kona Windsurf World Champppionship 2010 weather permitting. The afternoon of Saturday the 6th will hold preliminaries and **Sunday the 7th** will be reserved for finals of the International Windsurfer One Design Freestyle & Slalom Cup.

8. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

All Sailing Instructions will be made available at registration an reviewed at each days start.





9. JURY

For The Kona Windsurfing World Championships 2010 , An International Jury according to RR 70.5 will be appointed. Their decisions are final and can not be appealed according to RR 70.4.

For the International Windsurfer One Design Freestyle & Slalom Cup. the appointed jury will rule as per freestyle and Slalom sailing instructions.

10. BUOYANCY

If personal buoyancy is prescribed, each competitor shall wear, above the waist, a jacket, harness, or vest with a minimum buoyancy of 4kgs. The buoyancy shall be tested with a metal weight of 4kgs which shall remain supported for a minimum of 5 minutes in fresh water.

11. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors take part in all races in their own risk. The organizing authority or any of their officials or representatives are not responsible, under any circumstances, for any damage, loss or injury either ashore or on the water either persons or equipment. Participation in this event or supporting events is at the sole discretion of the sailors, who acknowledge this with the registration.

12. CHARTER BOARDS

The charter fee for:

- Adults are \$200 for a complete set or \$130 for the board ONLY.
- Cadets are \$110 for complete set or \$85 for board ONLY.

Booking prior to September 15th is recommended.
